



## OHIO YOUTH WORKS PROGRAM

### Participant Frequently Asked Questions

OYWP helps match youth ages 14 and 15 from Lucas County to meaningful work experience through the Ohio Youth Works Program. Please read below for answers to frequently asked questions about the program.

When registration opens, how will I register? Registration will be online. You will need a computer or a smartphone that is connected to the Internet in order to register. When the registration period opens, there will be a link on the website for the 2017 Ohio Youth Works Program registration. You may come to Pathway and the OYWP offices at 505 Hamilton Street, Toledo, Ohio, to complete the registration if you are unable to access a computer. Hours for in-person registration will from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

What is the maximum income eligibility for my family?

What other criteria must I meet to enroll in the program? Applicants must be 14 or 15 years of age by May 31, 2017.

Do I need my parent or guardian with me to meet with a caseworker after registration if I am approved? Yes.

Who can participate in the Ohio Youth Works Program? Participants must be between the ages of 14 and 15, and live in Lucas County.

How much does it pay? The rate of pay is \$10.00 per hour.

Do I get paid for holidays? No. Program participants will only be paid the hours actually worked.

How often do I get paid, and how? Participants will be paid weekly on Friday beginning the week after training has been completed. Participants will receive a pay card, and their earnings will be direct deposited into their account. The pay card can be used to get cash at ATMs and for shopping at other locations.
